Carlos **es simpático**.



Ana **es simpática**.

Ser with adjectives

- **Adjectives** are words that describe people or things.
- You can use the verb **ser** with **adjectives** to describe what someone is like.



Pedro **es** pelirrojo.



Rosa y Julio **son** inteligentes.

Subject pronouns

- In Spanish, you don't usually need the subject pronoun if it's clear who the subject is.

¿Cómo **es** el profesor?

Es bajo y gracioso.

¿Cómo **son** Leticia y Diego?

Son simpáticos.

Negation: no

- To say what someone is not like, put **no** in front of the verb.

No soy bajo. Soy alto.
