Infinitives

- An **infinitive** tells the meaning of the verb without naming any subject or tense.
- There are three kinds of **infinitives** in Spanish:
 - those ending in **-ar**, **cantar** *to sing*
 - those ending in **-er**, **comer** *to eat*
 - and those ending in **-ir**. **escribir** *to write*

Gustar

- Just like **nouns**, **infinitives** can be used after a verb like **gustar** to say what you and others like to do.

follows gustar

Me **gusta** la música.

I like music.

Me **gusta** cantar.

I like to sing.

Gusta with infinitives

- Always use **gusta** (not **gustan**) with **infinitives**.

Me **gustan** los deportes.

I like sports.

Me **gusta** **jugar** al tenis.

I like to play tennis.
