The verb querer

- To say what you or others want, use a form of the verb **querer**.
- The form you use depends on the subject.

yo **quiero**

nosotros(as) **queremos**

tú **quieres**

vosotros(as) **queréis**

Ud., él, ella **quiere**

Uds., ellos, ellas **quieren**

Querer with a noun or infinitive

- Just as with **gustar**, you can use a **noun** or an **infinitive** after a form of the verb **querer** to say what you and others *want* or *want to do*.

Quiero fruta.

I want some fruit.

¿Que *quieres* hacer?

What do you want to do?

Quiero comer.

I want to eat.

Quiero escuchar música.

I want to listen to music.
