## Irregular yo forms

- The following **-er** verbs have irregular **yo** forms.

	<b>hacer</b> <i>to do, to make</i>	<b>poner</b> <i>to put</i>	<b>traer</b> <i>to bring</i>
yo	<b>hago</b>	<b>pongo</b>	<b>traigo</b>
tú	haces	pones	traes
Ud., él, ella	hace	pone	trae
nosotros(as)	hacemos	ponemos	traemos
vosotros(as)	hacéis	ponéis	traéis
Uds., ellos, ellas	hacen	ponen	traen

yo	<b>sé</b>	<b>veo</b>	<b>salgo</b>
tú	sabes	ves	sales
Ud., él, ella	sabe	ve	sale
nosotros(as)	sabemos	vemos	salimos
vosotros(as)	sabéis	veis	salís
Uds., ellos, ellas	saben	ven	salen

## Using de

- The preposition **de** is used after **salir** to talk about leaving a place.

**Salgo de** mi casa a las siete. *I leave my house at seven.*

- It is used after **saber** to say how much someone knows about something.

No **sé** mucho **de** arte. *I don't know much about art.*
